Design brief and aim


To have an open, contemporary yet functional kitchen that accentuates a large window overlooking the garden.

How this was accomplishedThe designers have replaced the traditional platform along the kitchen window with an L-shaped island a little away from it. The big floor to ceiling opening provides ample light penetration throughout the day, bringing in a sense of purity along with enhancing the whole simple but bold look. A small breakfast counter sits to one side and adequate space has been provided for each appliance taking adequate space has been provided for each appliance taking the furniture adds to the space and the use of materials such as Kota for flooring, exposed RCC slab and carefully-designed and picked furniture units enriches the overall look.
